




Ardross Primary School

We would be grateful if you could keep an eye on how much money your child is going through & perhaps adjust what you give them accordingly – some children are having 2 slices of toast or a slice of toast and a scone – or sometimes 2 scones – each day. This adds up to a fair bit over the course of a week & children don't always understand that their money has run out! Obviously children can bring their own snacks and/or packed lunch if they wish.
